

What does it mean to organise sustainable events?

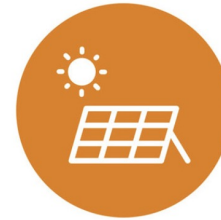
- The venue can be easily accessed on foot and by public transport.

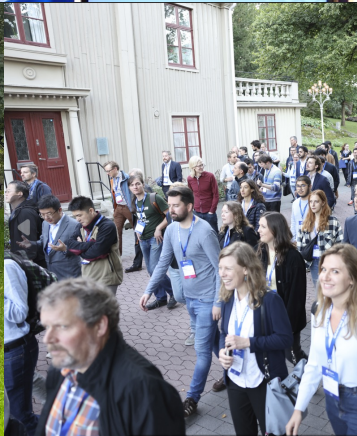
